



Province I Episcopal Church Women President's Annual Report 2023-2024

We held our fourth virtual Annual Meeting on June 17, 2023. Our guest speaker was Emily Keniston, Director of Faith Formation for the Episcopal Diocese of Maine. Her keynote topic was, *"IT'S ALL ABOUT GOOD NEWS: Teaching it, Preaching it, Using* it. Being the church we love for love". The group had some interesting discussion after the talk and the recording was shared in a podcast. Emily's honorarium of \$300 was sent to **ProGente Connections**, who do work with immigration in Framingham, MA and who gave a "spotlight" talk at a prior annual meeting.

The remainder of 2023-24 was a year to revision and refresh. After holding steady with our executive committee, we decided to take a sabbatical from October 2023 until Easter 2024.
